# MACKAYE HARBOR WATER DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES October 4, 2021

## CALL TO ORDER

The Board of Commissioners for MacKaye Harbor Water District met in special session on October 4 at the residence of San Olson and via zoom. Chairman Olson called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Present were commissioners KC Jennings and Walt Krumbholz and clerk Helen Cosgrove.

## A. Agate Beach Lane Project Financing

Krumbholz said he received a term sheet from Cashmere Valley Bank, consistent with what was previously discussed; years 1 thru 5 at 1.1%, years 6 to 10 at 1.65% and years 11 thru 16 estimated to be 2.17%; proposal good for 45 days beginning 9/22; they have a debt service cover of 1.2% but could be less since bond payments would be from additional fees to be assessed the customers; no prepayment penalty, no bank loan fees.

The meeting adjourned to executive session at 3:55 p.m. The meeting returned to open session at 4:45 p.m.

Krumbholz said Cashmere was very flexible. Olson asked if the loan could be higher such as \$250,000. Krumbholz felt the bank would be amenable to a larger loan amount. Olson asked what it might cost the customers monthly. It was estimated to be about \$25.00 per month.

Krumbholz had also contacted Savi Bank; expected rates to be higher than Cashmere's but would be more flexible for construction financing; would get a term sheet prepared, hadn't received it yet. That would give 4 bank contacts, two that presented term sheets, one that was not interested and one with no response. The woman at Savi Bank suggested he contact Kirk McMillan a commissioner with the Cattle Point Water District on San Juan Island. Krumbholz did contact him, they are a municipal water district, 43 hookups, expanding to 50; converted to a water district in 2017, distribution system was installed in the 70's, have a desal plant; need to spend \$1,000,000 to completely redo distribution system; they applied to the USDA for funding and received \$600,000 in loans and \$400,000 in grants; the term is 40 years. Cosgrove to send term sheets to Darla O'Connor at USDA, explain loan payments from banks would be a hardship to the customers. USDA will only fund a completed project, financing for construction could be done through one of the banks. The meeting recessed at 5:10 p.m. to be reconvened on October 7 at 3:30 p.m. The meeting reconvened on October 7 at 3:30 p.m.

The meeting went into executive session at 3:30. The meeting returned to open session at 4:42 p.m.

It was agreed to move forward with Alice Haefele. Cosgrove to contact her, ask her to send MHWD a contract for services, find out what her rate is. A decision will be made at the next meeting on October 18<sup>th</sup>. Cosgrove to contact the other candidates and let them know that they were not selected.
